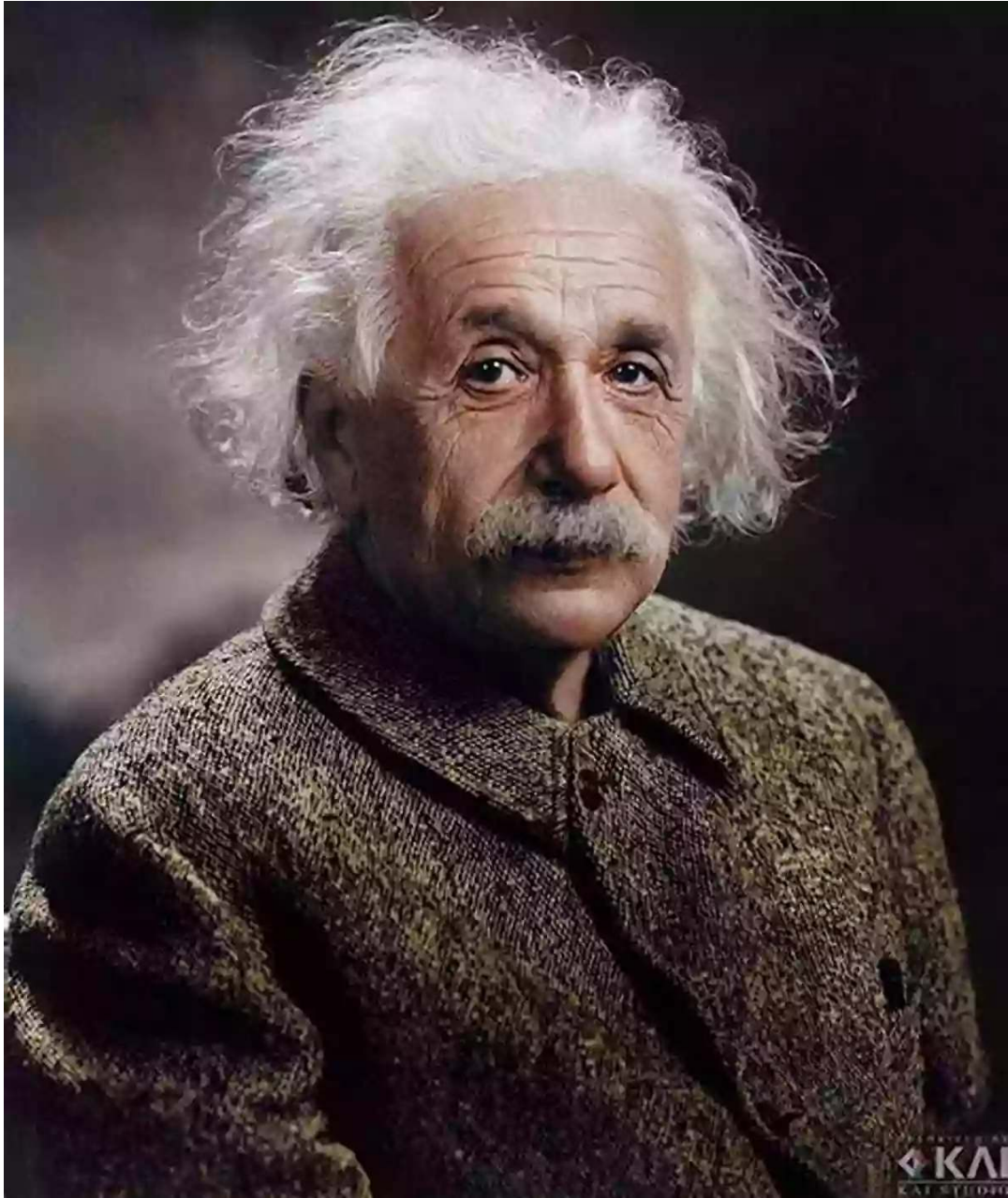


# 11 Scientists Who Held On To Strong Faith While Wrestling With The Mystery

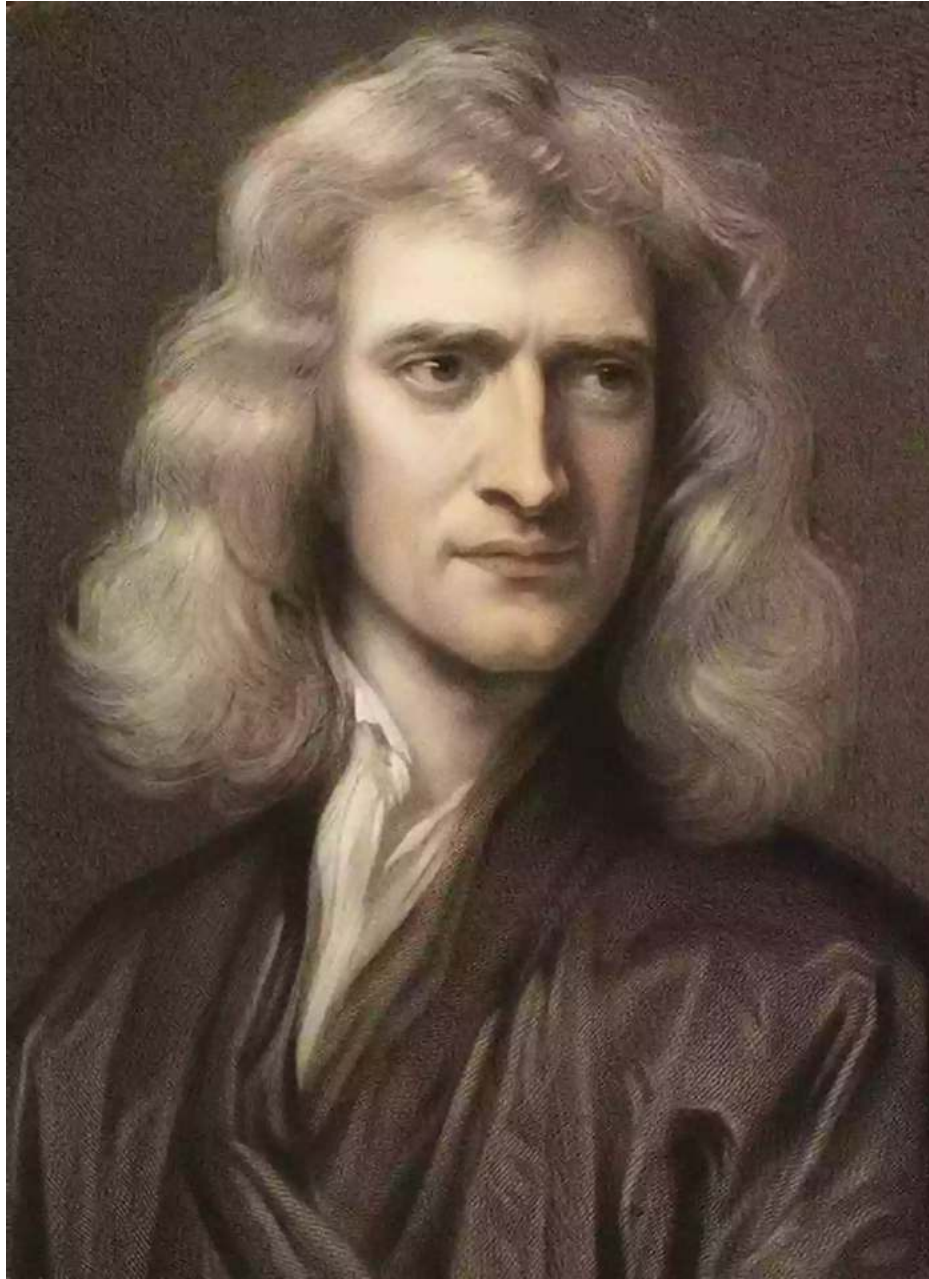

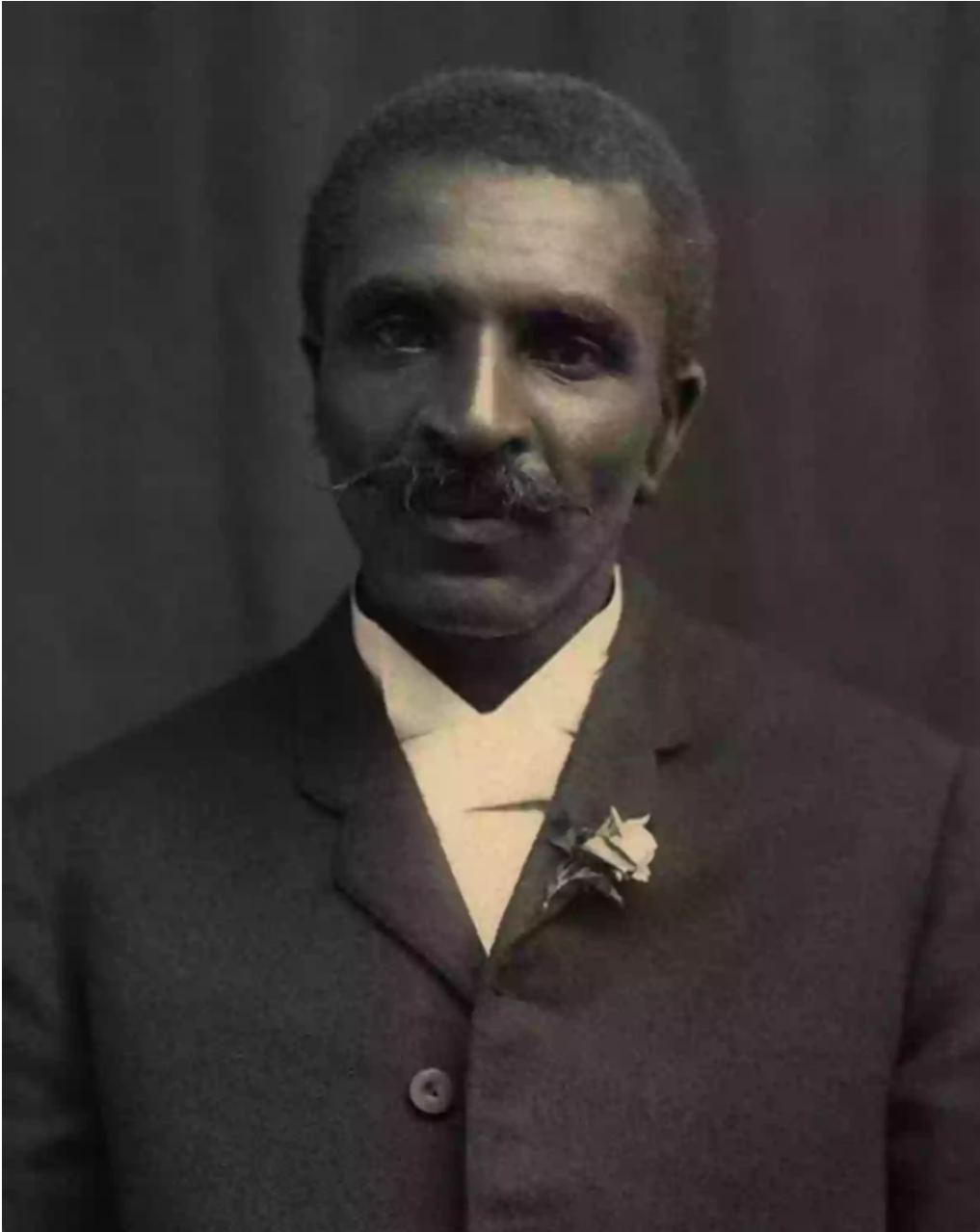

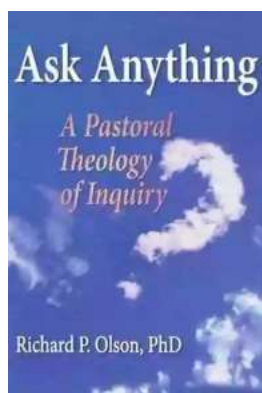
