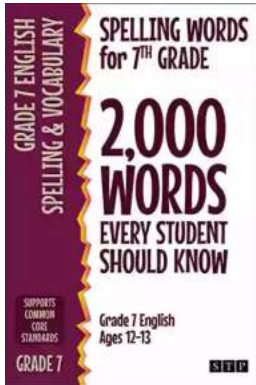

This means that while the words may look "easier" on the surface, you must be aware of the different ways the word can function in a sentence. For example, when most people think of the word "gravity," they think of the force that keeps us from floating into the air. However, in the sentence "The gravity of the situation wiped the smile from her face," the word "gravity" has a much different meaning. When preparing to learn ACT vocabulary, make sure you learn all of the different definitions of a word and how it functions in a sentence.

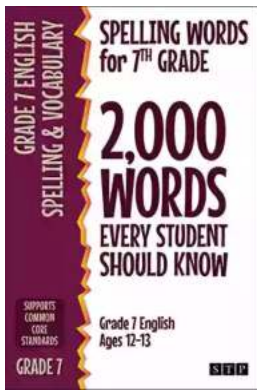

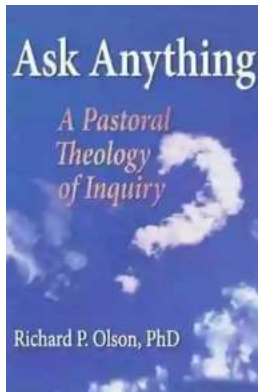

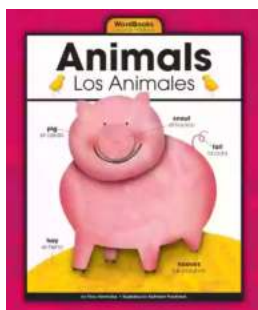
