

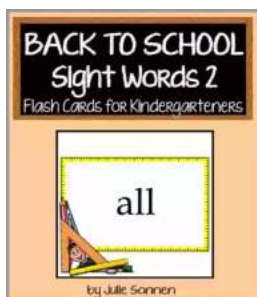

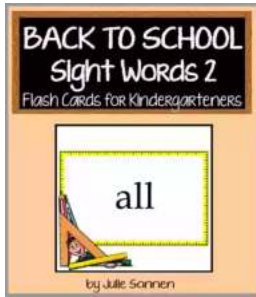

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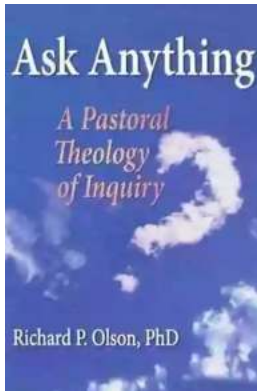
Get Ready to GO BACK TO SCHOOL!

These flash cards are fun and easy to use!

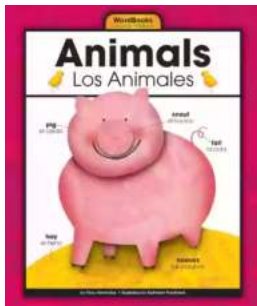
- * Fun flashcard image - Each word is paired with an engaging image to keep your child's attention.
