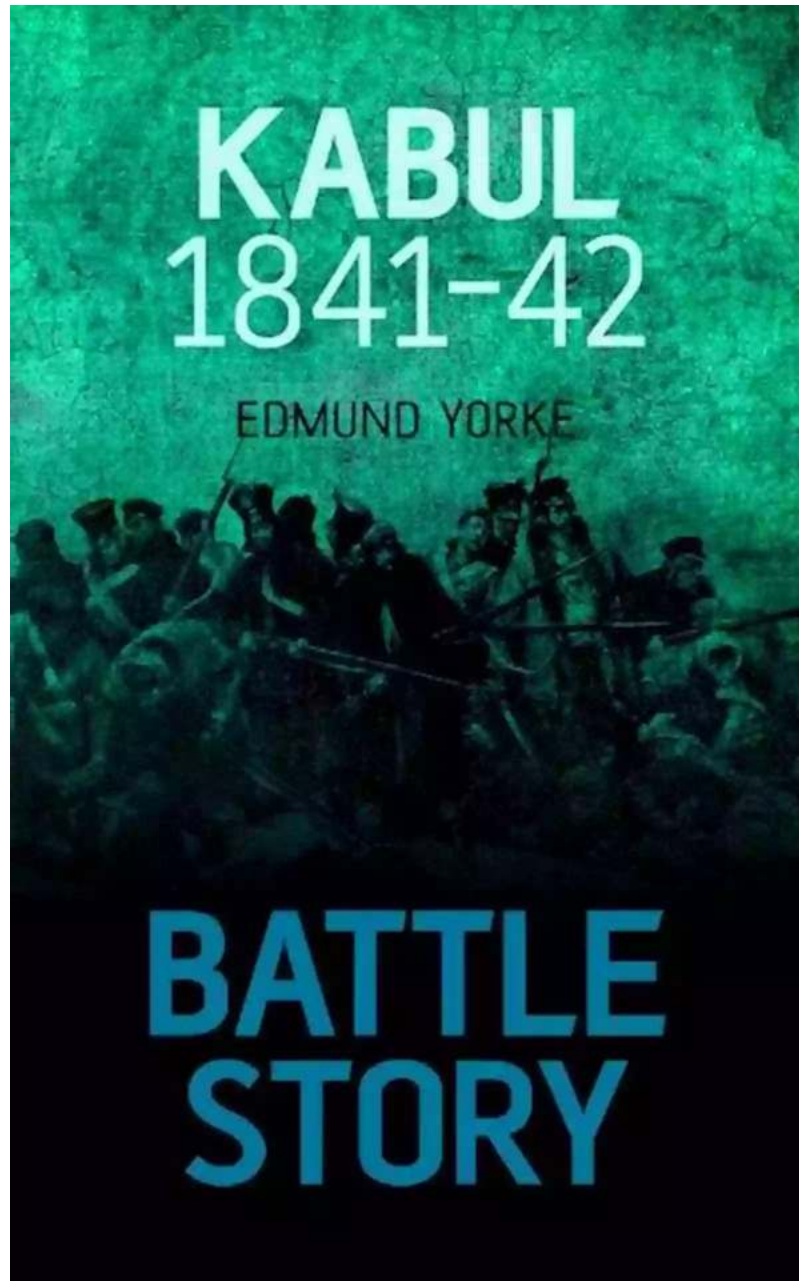

Kabul is a name that has had much resonance in current affairs over the last few years, however its place in military history can be charted much further back to the first British incursions into Afghanistan during the 19th century. In retribution an army was sent to support the British retreat from Afghanistan, laying waste to the city of Kabul on their way.
