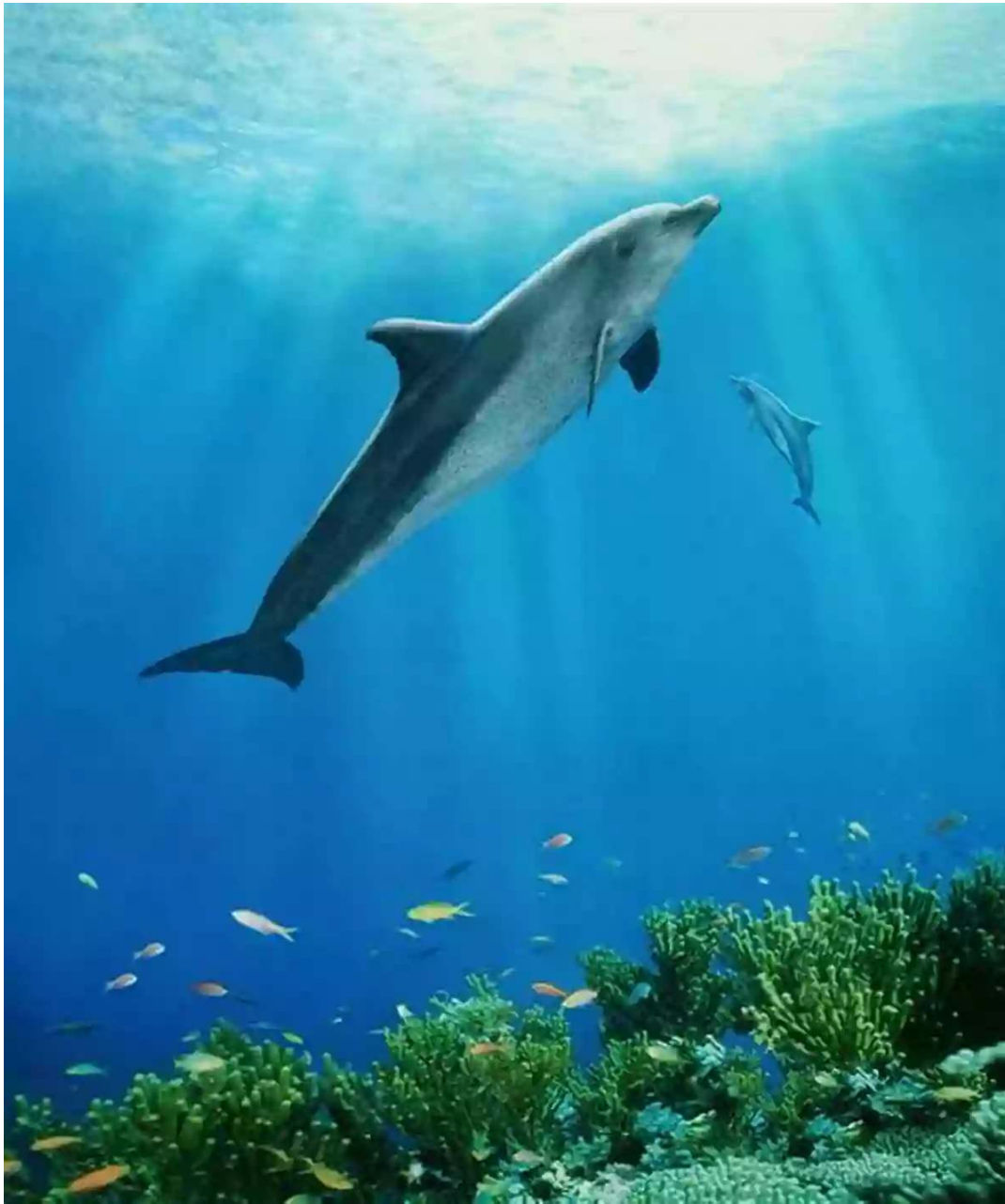


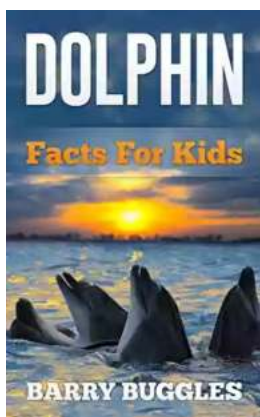

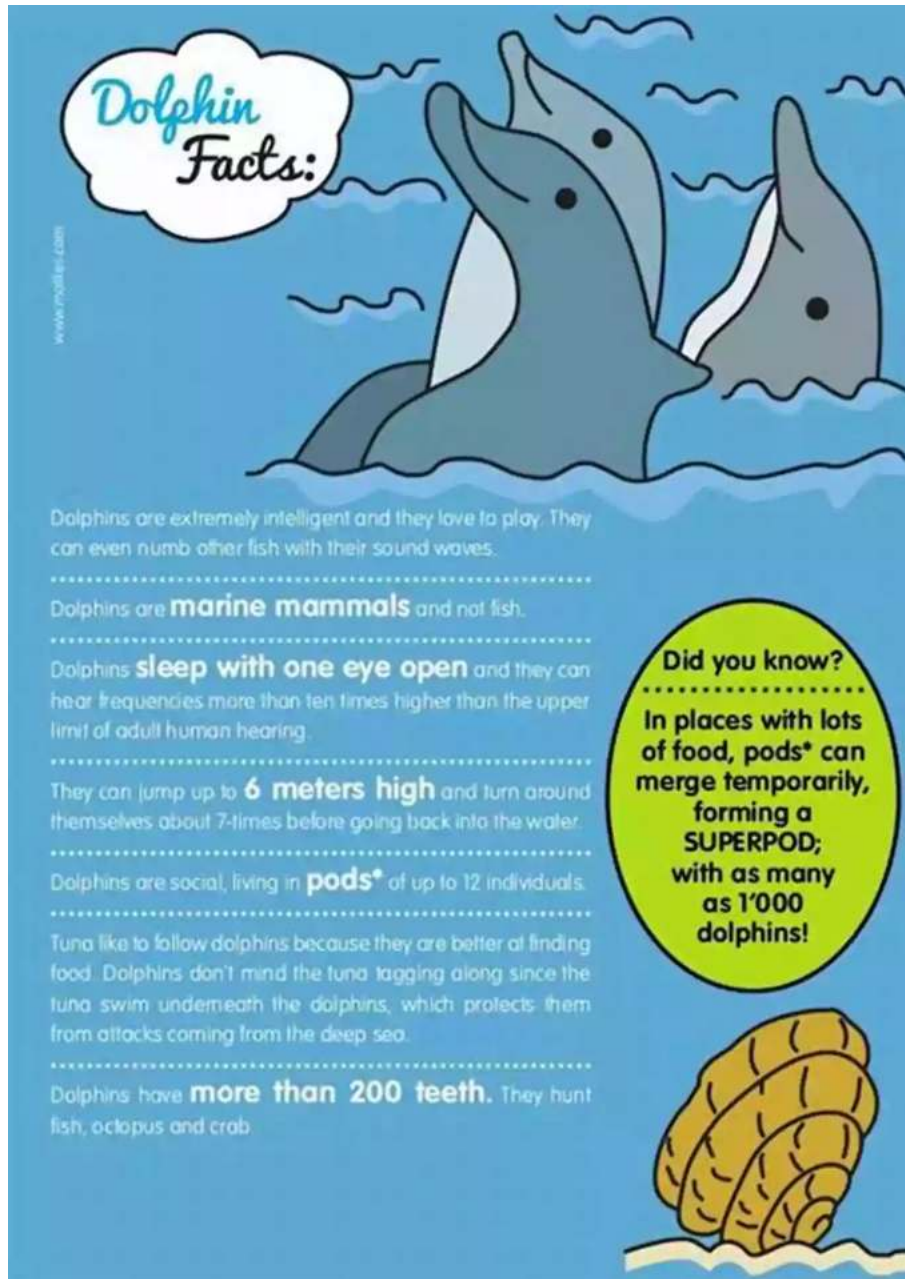
2. Dolphin Species
