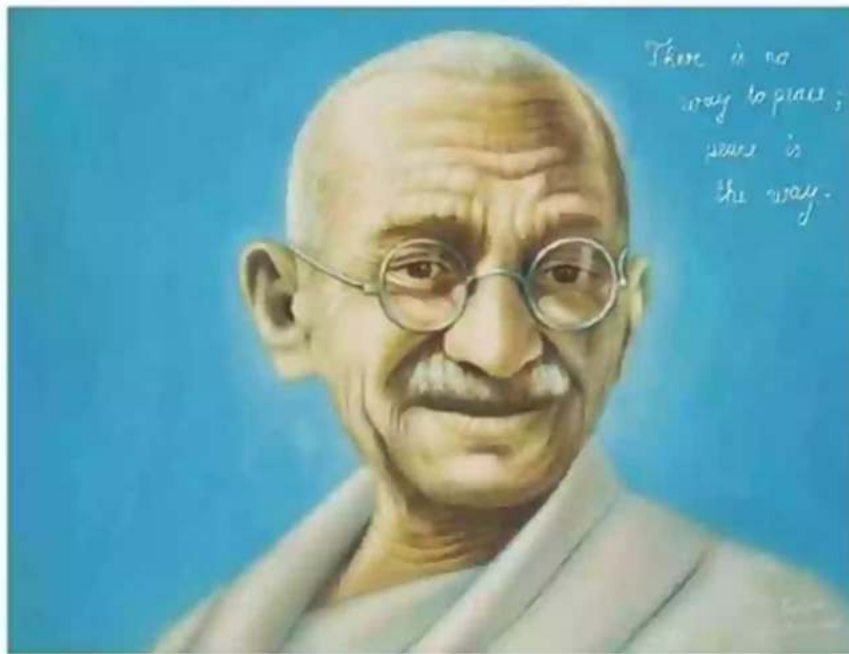

## Life of Mahatma Gandhi

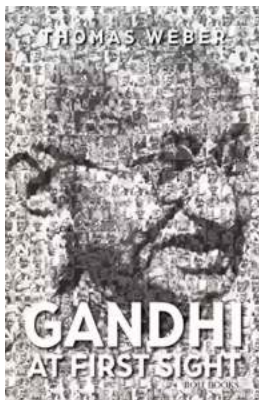
