Grease Spots, Mustard Stains, and Freedom in Christ



Just as the grease spot and mustard stain don't define our clothing, our past or imperfections don't define us in Christ. We are free to embrace our identity as


children of God, clothed in righteousness and equipped to live a life of purpose, joy, and love.


A simple look at a simple faith...




