She examines how color-based racial thinking gave way to more nuanced debates about identity, complicating conceptions of blackness and racialization. A deeply interdisciplinary book with a focus on recovering subaltern resistance, *Slave in a Palanquin* offers a vital new portrait of the local and transnational worlds of the colonial-era Asian slave trade in the Indian Ocean.
