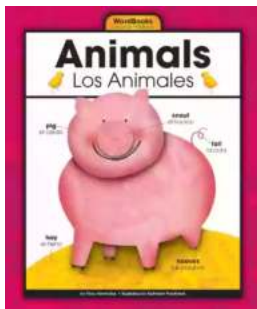
Mikhail Vladimirovich Rodzianko (1859-1924) was a leading Russian statesman during the last years of the reign of Tsar Nicholas II. 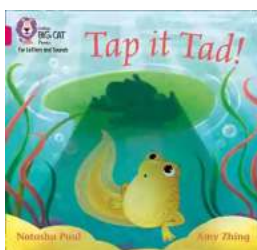
