


July 24, 1915 was supposed to be Chicago's social event of a lifetime, but turned into a tragedy unlike any other.



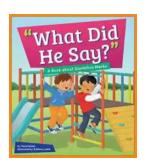
