



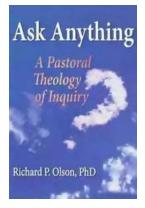
He was a great national hero. Study on his life and time shall create immense inspiration to the generations of today and tomorrow.


