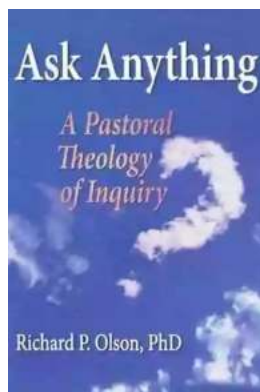

It is not the mission as we are expecting for, therefore, people's judgment about them is using the bad image of MARCOSES in exchange of covering up the

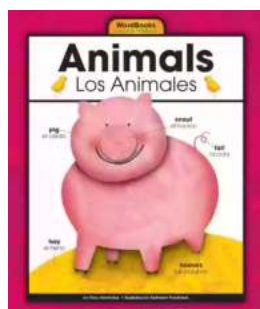
