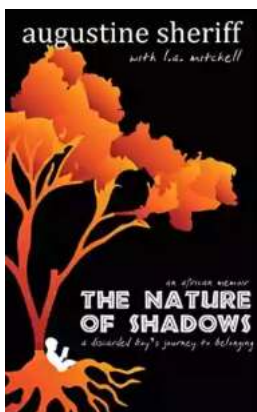

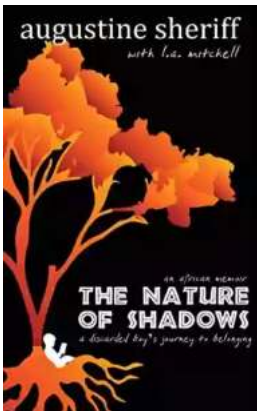

So begins the immersive, triumphant story of one discarded boy's journey into manhood against incredible odds.

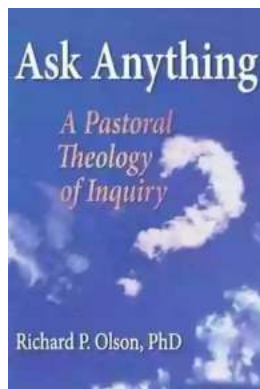
From navigating the often-corrupt Liberian political and educational system to extracting himself from his oppressor's polygamist network at the tender age of

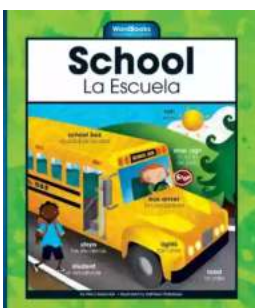
