



2. The Fall of the Berlin Wall (November 9, 1989)






5. Marriage Equality (June 26, 2015)

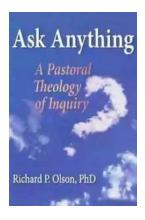

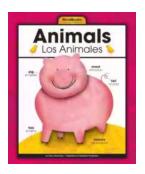

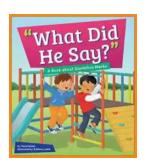
