

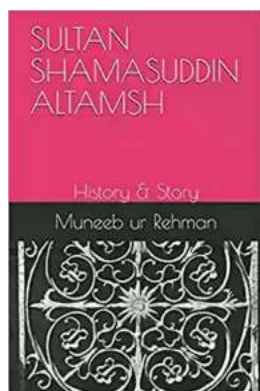

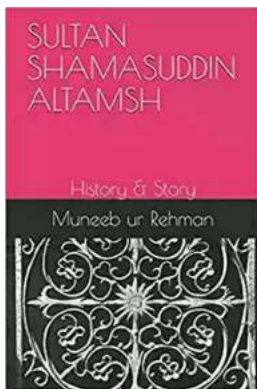

Nassiruddin Qubacha had gone to involve the stronghold of Oach with independents expert from Delhi.

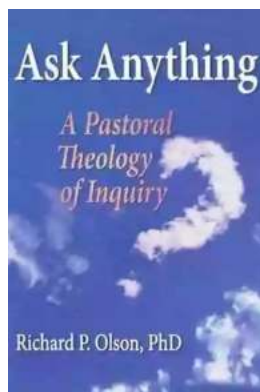
