

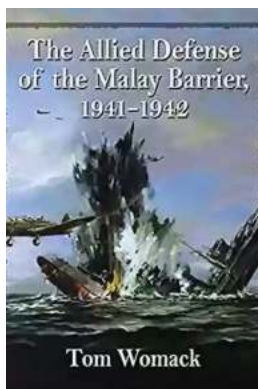

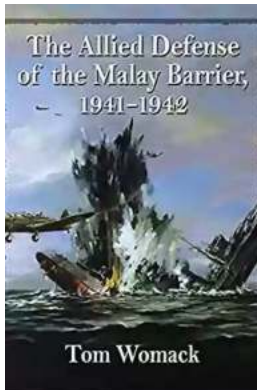

Though few realize it, the Netherlands East Indies were the object of Japan's attack on Pearl Harbor in December 1941.
