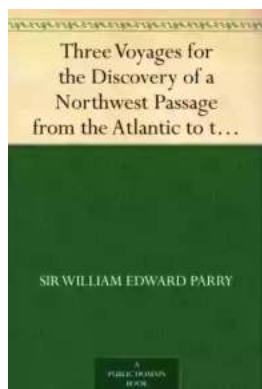

The Second Voyage: The Hudson's Bay Company's Pursuit

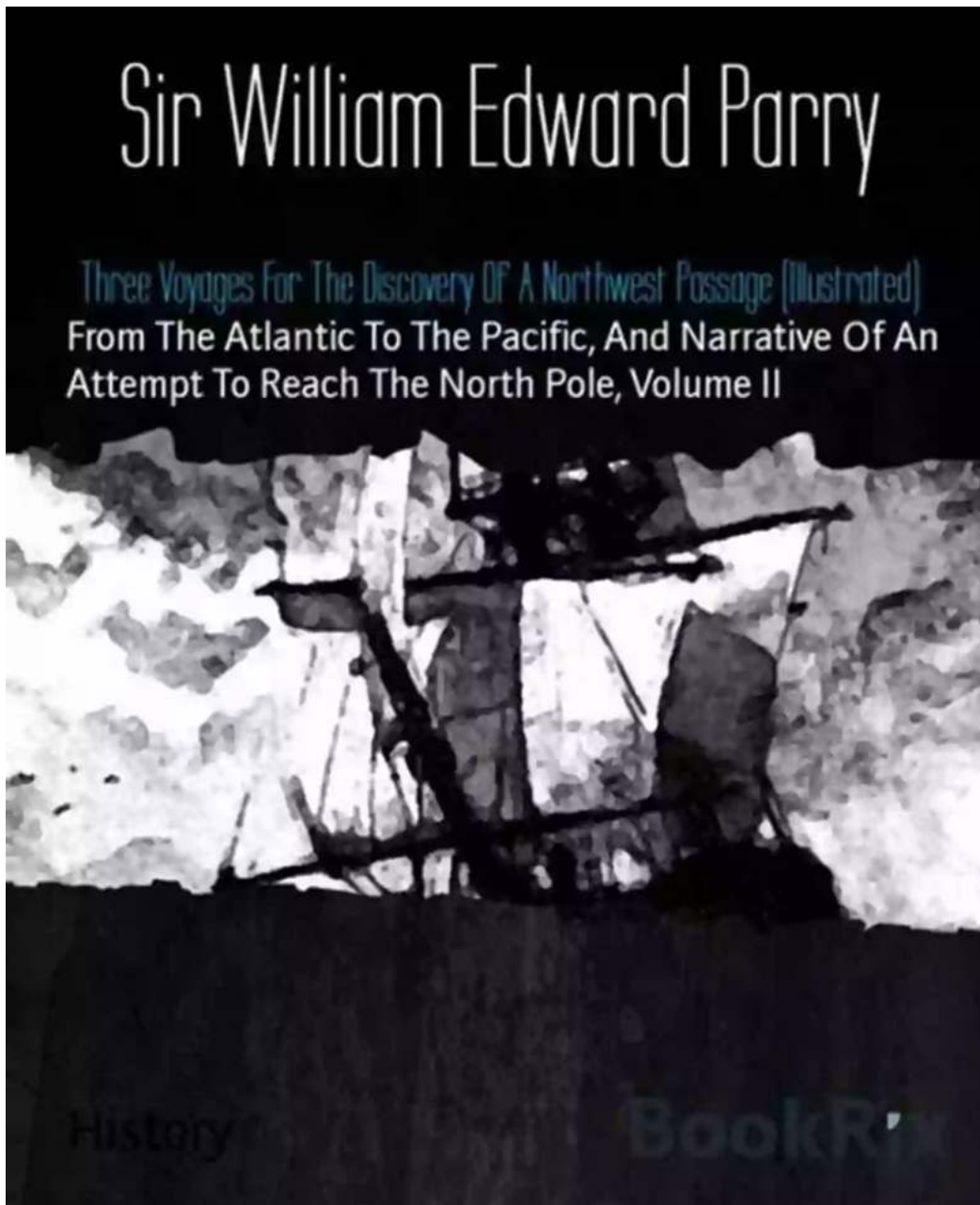
