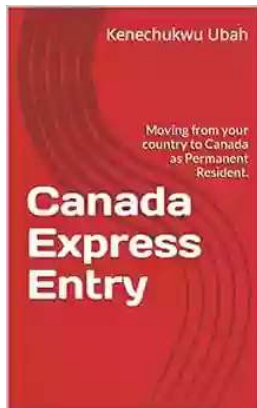

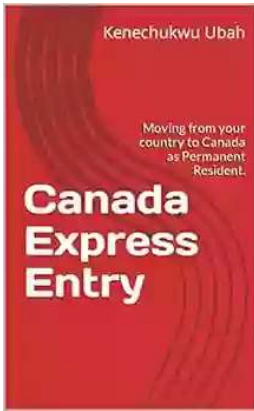

Provincial Nomination Program (PNP)

Also, in this program, you can be nominated regardless of your age. You will be required to have a minimum of 1 year paid work experience and must have a degree.

Foreign Skilled Worker Program (FSWP)

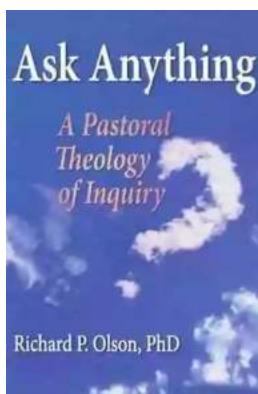
Unlike PNP, FSWP offers you the opportunity to live anywhere in Canada upon relocation. You will be Invited To Apply (ITA) from the Express Entry pool by IRCC

in a draw done every 2 weeks. You need a at least 3 years paid work experience so as to gather enough point, as well as having a degree.

What's the Catch?

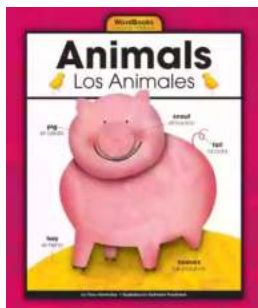
You might ask, what's the catch?
