

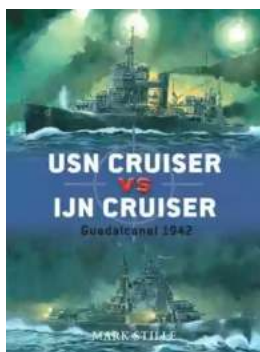
USN Cruiser Vs IJN Cruiser Guadalcanal 1942 Duel: The Epic Battle that Shook the Waters

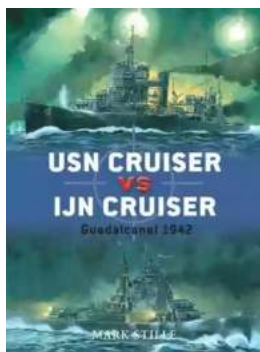
