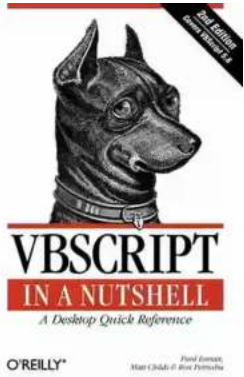

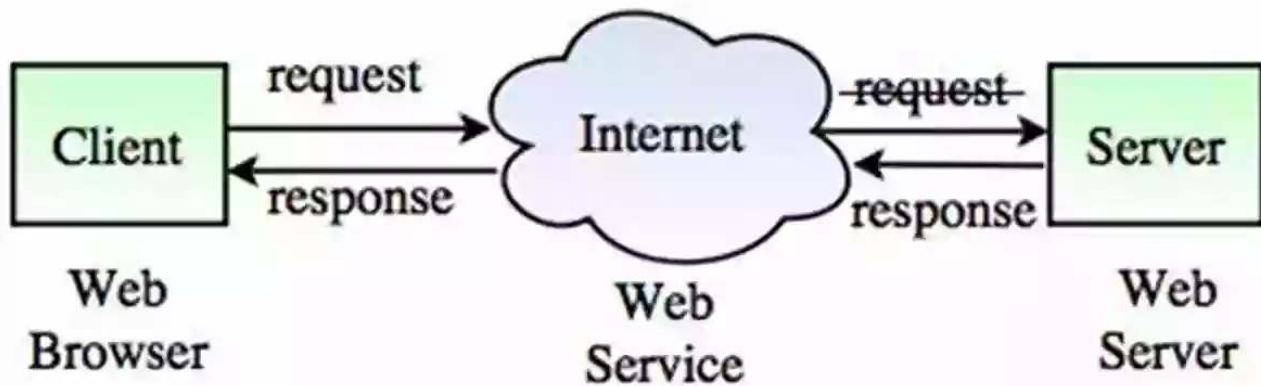


Fig. Client-Side Scripting

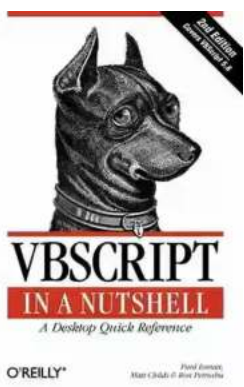
