



Juche, a self-reliant ideology developed by former leader Kim II-sung, emphasizes national independence and the absolute authority of the ruling

Korean Workers' Party. The government maintains strict control over all aspects of society, from the media to the economy, resulting in a highly centralized power structure.

In contrast, the South Korean political system, officially known as the Republic of Korea (ROK), is based on a democratic framework. After overthrowing its authoritarian regime in the late 20th century, South Korea embraced democracy and established a multi-party system.
